PRESENTATIONS



The Board congratulated the Sheriff's Office for its 275th anniversary of service to the residents of Fairfax County.

The Sheriff's Office was created in 1742, at the same time Fairfax County was formed, and is now one of three public safety

agencies responsible for the safety and well-being of the 1.1 million residents of Fairfax County.

With over 600 employees, the Fairfax County Sheriff's Office is among the largest in Virginia. The position of sheriff is established by the Virginia Constitution. At best count, there have been <u>77</u> <u>sheriffs</u> in Fairfax County since 1742, including the current sheriff, Stacey Kincaid. Though early sheriffs served for terms of two years, the people elect the current position every four years.

The Board also designated:

- June 19-25 as Fairfax County Sheriff's Office Week
- May 2017, as Older Americans Month and Adult Abuse Prevention Month.
- May 2017, as Lyme Disease Awareness Month.
- June 2017, as Fight the Bite Awareness Month.
- May 21-27, 2017, as Public Works Week.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

• The Board deferred a public hearing until July 20 at 3:30 p.m. on proposed Modifications to the Comprehensive Plan Amendment Process.

Recommendations are proposed to modify the Comprehensive Plan Amendment Process, currently known as Fairfax Forward, to improve public participation in land use planning efforts. The major proposed modification would incorporate the Comprehensive Plan Amendment Work Program, a new nomination based review cycle, known as the Site-Specific Plan Amendment Process (SSPA).

• The Board endorsed a recommended list of potential improvements for consideration for the Transform I-66 Outside the Beltway project.
