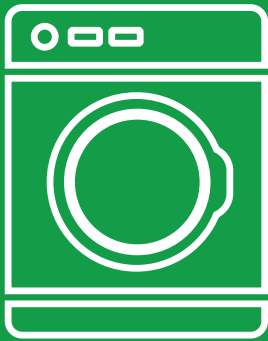


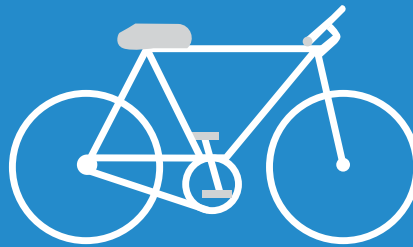
KNOW YOUR NUMBERS: SAVE MONEY, REDUCE EMISSIONS

Whether you're at home or on the go, reducing your personal emissions gives back to the environment and your wallet.



\$370

The money you could save over the product's lifetime by switching to an ENERGY STAR®-certified clothes washer. ¹



\$613

The money you could save per year by walking or biking instead of driving for at least half of your short (3-mile or less) trips, based on national averages.
