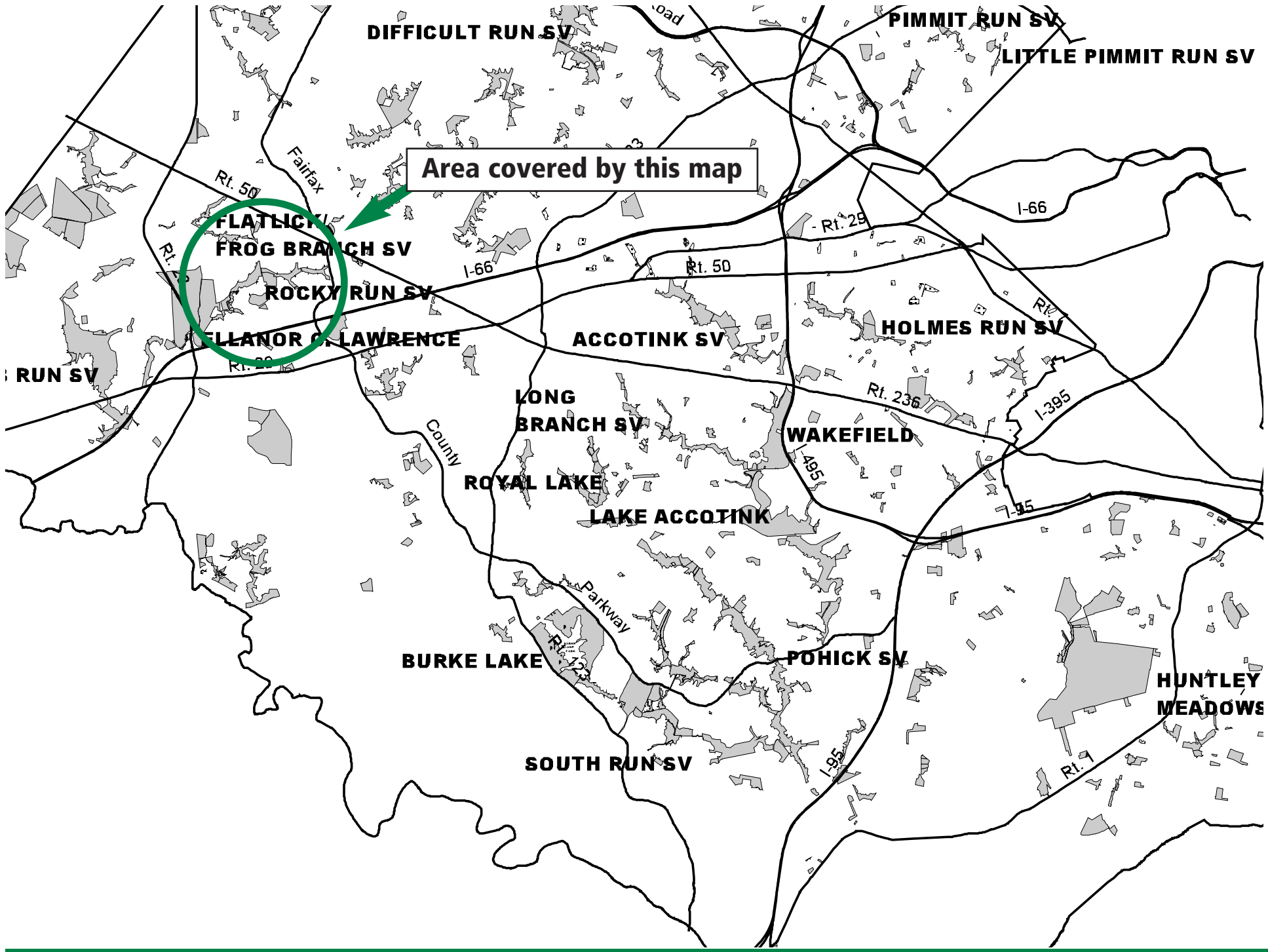
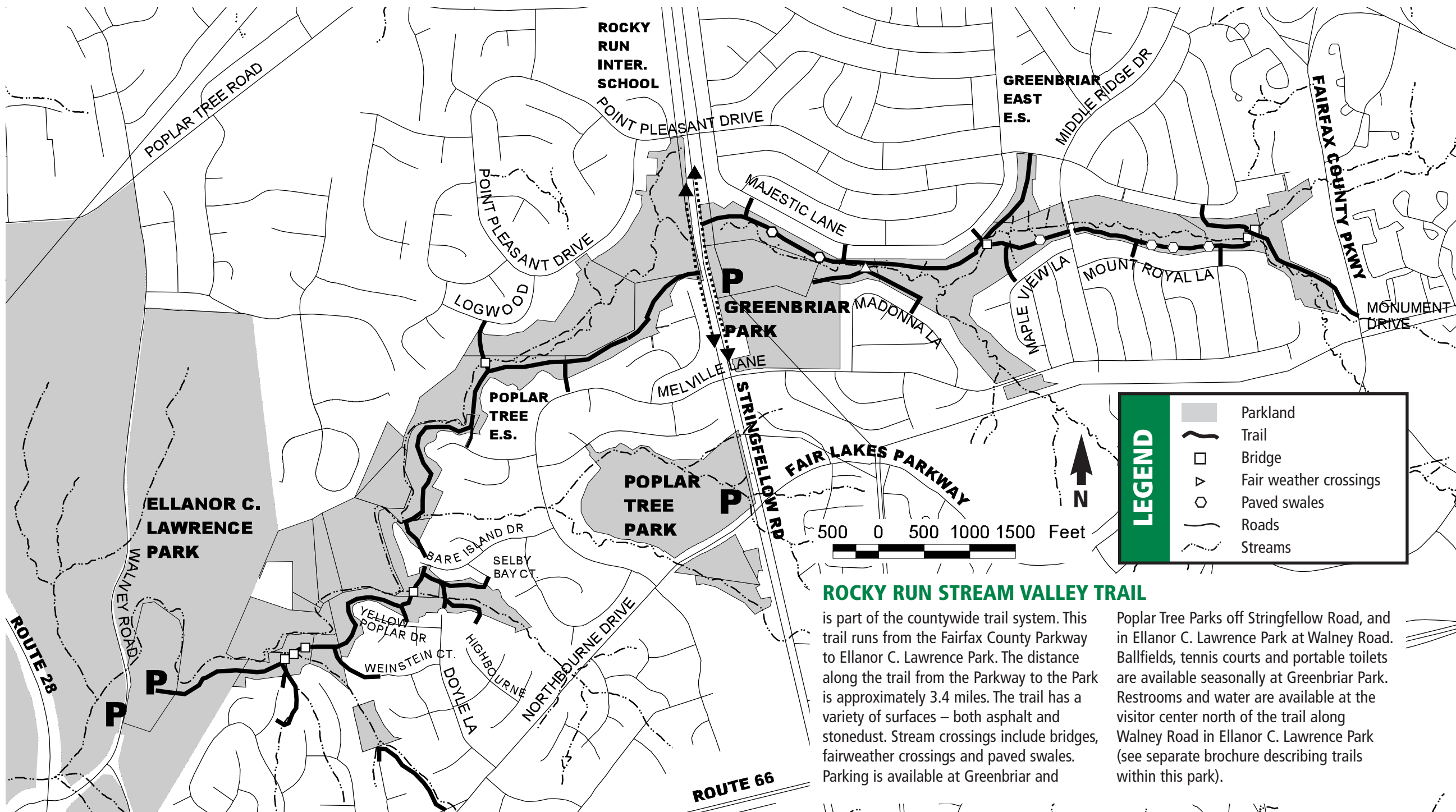


Rocky Run Stream Valley Trail

ROCKY RUN STREAM VALLEY TRAIL

is part of the countywide trail system. This trail runs from the Fairfax County Parkway to Ellanor C. Lawrence Park. The distance along the trail from the Parkway to the Park is approximately 3.4 miles. The trail has a variety of surfaces – both asphalt and stonedust. Stream crossings include bridges, fairweather crossings and paved swales. Parking is available at Greenbriar and

Poplar Tree Parks off Stringfellow Road, and in Ellanor C. Lawrence Park at Walney Road. Ballfields, tennis courts and portable toilets are available seasonally at Greenbriar Park. Restrooms and water are available at the visitor center north of the trail along Walney Road in Ellanor C. Lawrence Park (see separate brochure describing trails within this park).
