### How Capital Bikeshare works

- Bicycle transit service allows people to rent a bike and ride to one of 700+ stations in 7 jurisdictions
- Serves as first and last mile from Metro
- Ridership fees
  - Members pay \$95 per year for unlimited 45-minute rides on classic bikes
  - Non-members pay \$1 to unlock a bike and \$0.05 per minute on classic bikes
  - Capital Bikeshare for All for low-income residents gives unlimited 60-minute riders including e-bikes
- Bicycles designed with safety in mind
  - Upright and slow, always-on lights, bright red
  - Few reported crashes in Fairfax County

### How People Use Capital Bikeshare

- Transfer to/from Metro or Connector/Metrobus
- Run errands
- Go to appointments
- Shop or visit restaurants
- Fun rides along trails
- Facilitates one-way trips
- Replaces short car trips



# Dranesville & Hunter Mill Districts Bikeshare Funding

- Transportation Alternatives Program grant for 10 stations and approximately 69 electric bikes
- Five stations proposed for Dranesville District
- One station proposed for Hunter Mill District
- Additional stations proposed in other Supervisor Districts will be covered by future virtual public meetings

#### Rationale for station locations

- Dranesville District has only one Capital Bikeshare station
- Build on existing network in Reston
- Provide first and last mile trips to and from the Innovation Center Metro
- Provide connection between residential areas and nearby businesses
- Meet technical requirements such as solar access and safety
- Meet programmatic requirements such as residential density and attract ridership and revenue









### Electric bikes (e-bikes)

- Fairfax County hosted contractor-provided e-bikes since July 2020
- Plan to acquire approximately 69 e-bikes with this grant
- E-bikes generated 14% of trips despite averaging 8% of bike fleet from July 2020-August 2023
- Can lock to public bike rack instead a docking station (i.e. dockless) with a ¼ mile of a station (service area)
  - 6% of trips started or ended outside of dock Countywide
  - Equity members ride for free for 60 minutes and \$2 out of station fee waived
- Buying our own ensures future e-bike service as black colored contractor-provided e-bikes will gradually phase out
- E-bike capital cost \$3,900 versus \$1,100 for classic bikes
  - Funded by federal grant and users pay e-bike operations cost






