

APPLICATION TO DISCHARGE GROUNDWATER FROM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK REMEDIATION SITE

All applicants for approval to discharge contaminated groundwater to the sanitary sewer from remediation projects must apply for a Virginia Department of Environmental Quality Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Permit. Discharge approval will be limited to the interim period necessary for CAP Permit issuance. 1. Remediation site owner (business name, address, contact person, phone number).
2. Remediation site address (street name and number, city, state and zip).
3. Current tenant at the remediation site (business name, address, contact person, phone number).
4. Remediation project contractor (business name, address, contact person, phone number).

5. Billing address (name, title, and address of responsible party to whom Fairfax County will send invoice for sanitary sewer service). *Sanitary sewer usage will be billed at the current sewer use rate in accordance with Fairfax County Code Section 67.1-10-2(d).*

6. Background information on the site.
 - Product released (e.g. diesel fuel, gasoline) and estimated quantity.

 - Current status of remediation project (e.g. tank removed, contaminated soil removed, tank replaced, test wells installed, pumping wells installed) and Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and Fire Marshal involvement to date.

7. Analytical testing of the contaminated water to date and proposed testing of treated remediation wastewater prior to discharge to the sanitary sewer (parameters to be tested and schedule). *Periodic sampling will be established by the County as appropriate to ensure compliance with limits applicable to released product (e.g. benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene (BTEX); total recoverable petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH); total organic carbon (TOC); total suspended solids (TSS); total lead). Discharge must comply with limitations under Chapter 67.1 of the Fairfax County Code.*

8. Proposed connection to the sanitary sewer or method of release into the sanitary sewer; projected flow rate, gallons per minute (gpm) and gallons per day (gpd), and schedule for release. *Connection must be either underground or within the facility; above ground piping or emptying of drums to an external manhole will not be authorized. Plumbing plans of the proposed connection must be submitted to the Building Plan Review Division, Office of Building Code Services, Department of Public Works and Environmental Services, 12055 Government Center Parkway, Suite 230, for review and approval.*

9. Description of the Corrective Action Plan (CAP), anticipated project duration, and milestone schedule. *Attach copies of the CAP cover letter and CAP General Permit Certification Statement submitted to DEQ.*

10. Wastewater treatment system design (drawings and narrative) and proposed frequency of monitoring the system (schedule for inspecting the system). *Typical systems include oil-water separator, aeration/ granular activated carbon (GAC). Required documentation will include flow metering of wastewater discharged to the sanitary sewer and a record of product recovery and disposal. Periodic reporting to the County will be required.*

11. **CERTIFICATION STATEMENT.** *An Authorized Representative of the Owner of the premises (as defined under Section 67.1-1-3 of the Fairfax County Code), not the Remediation Contractor, must sign the following statement. The application must bear the actual signature of the Owner's Authorized Representative; FAX copies will not be approved.*

"I certify under the penalty of law that this application and all attachments are, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for known violations."
